PROFILE

Born and raised in Hong Kong, Samuel Chan Kwan Chi has studied in the University of Hong Kong for Physics and Political Theory, Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts for Lighting Design and Yale School of Drama for Design.

He was an Artist in Residence in the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts. His lighting design work on *Twelfth Night* with the Yale Repertory Theatre was nominated for Outstanding Lighting Design by the Connecticut Critics Circle Awards in 2019. Samuel is also part of the winning team of the 2019 Robert LB Tobin Director-Designer Showcase for *Tosca*. He is currently at Dortmund with his fellowship at the Akademie für Theater und Digitalität, whereas he researches on the application of Artificial Intelligence on Theatrical Design.

Samuel's recent Lighting Design credits includes *The Plague* & *Yat-sen* for the Hong Kong Arts Festival, In additional to lighting design, Samuel also designs media and space for theatre and dances. His recent scenography works in includes *Wither Womb* with Chung Ying Theatre Company, *We are Spectacles* with Joseph Lee and *The world without News* with the Fableist Ensemble.

Samuel's artistic practice has gone beyond theatrical design. His installation *Aesthetics and Freedom of Human Beings* is one of the Finalist of the IFVA 2021, media art section. He is the director of *R. U. Human?* by arts group Inspire Workshop, an online immersive adaptation of Karel Čapek's *Rossum's Universal Robots*; and the main Collaborator *Seagull.Story* by Fableist Ensemble, an Instagram adaption of Chekhov's *The Seagull* in the Hong Kong context. Both projects are selected and funded under the Arts-go-digital initiatives by the Hong Kong Arts Development Council.
